Taumarunui Racing Club is offering a bursary to students for furthering their education with the emphasis on Equine Studies

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Students who have lived in the greater Taumarunui district for at least the past five years (time at boarding school included)
- Applicant's enrolment must be to the satisfaction of the Racing Clubs Bursary Committee
- Students must be enrolled in an Equine related course or Veterinary Studies

CRITERIA:

Successful applicants will be judged on the following:

- Ability to successfully complete the study
- Academic record
- Ability to complete studies without bursary support
- Genuine interest in horses and/or racing

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Taumarunui Racing Club will award a bursary of **up to** \$10,000 (ten thousand dollars) to the successful recipient/s for the year of application
- The bursary may be split between more than one recipient
- The bursary holder is required to report back to the Racing Club each semester and provide a summary of results for each semester
- The bursary holder will be reimbursed by direct credit into a nominated account upon proof of fees being paid
- Each year the bursary will be subject to funds being available
